- Continue learning by pursuing pastoral training and/or education.
- Additional responsibilities that benefit the church, as time allows and when requested by the pastors.

Qualifications:

- Sound character and integrity, meeting the biblical qualifications of an elder.
- A history of compassionate character, demonstrating the activity of the Holy Spirit with fruit.
- A heart of humility, evidenced in his willingness to shepherd and serve sacrificially.
- FBC member, or willing to become an FBC member.
- Complete agreement with FBC's doctrinal statement.
- A deep commitment to prayer and personal time in God's Word.
- Transparent in sharing, not only his strengths and victories, but his needs and faults.
- A love for God's Word and a passion for making disciples.
- A demonstrated gifting to teach and preach God's Word.
- Some experience or ability teaching kids and/or teens.
- Some experience in kids and/or teen ministry.
- Has demonstrated faithfulness in making disciples.
- Desired–experience with a church of at least 250 attendees.
- Have served as a pastor or willing to pursue pastoral training/education.
