Discussion Questions:

- 1. Have you noticed that some Christians seem to always be growing spiritually, while others seem to grow very little? If so, why do you think that is?
- 2. Why could there be a difference between what we say we believe and how we behave?
- 3. Let's talk about the **gospel**:
 - a. In your own words, what is the gospel?
 - b. What Scriptures could we look at to know the meaning of the *gospel*? (e.g. <u>Ephesians 2:1-10</u>; <u>Romans 3:23-25</u> & <u>Romans 6:22-23</u>; <u>John 14:6</u>)
- 4. Read <u>Psalm 1</u>.
 - a. What is the main idea of Psalm 1?
 - b. What might the illustration of roots have to do with the meaning of Psalm 1?
- 5. Read John 12:24-25.
 - a. Why do you think Jesus uses this illustration about a seed dying?
 - b. It's true that Jesus died to bear gospel fruit. Why must you also die to 'self' to bear gospel fruit? What might this *dying* look like in your life?
- 6. Do you have gospel roots? How do you know you do or you don't? (Please help one another answer this question, if needed).
- 7. What is one way God is challenging you to grow in Christ today?
