 - b. From the context, what can you tell about each of their heart postures?
4. What effect does *self-righteousness* vs. *humble honesty* have on a person? How might insecurity, shame, blame, and comparison detract from humble honesty?
5. Read [Hebrews 10:19-25](#).
 - a. What in this text exhibits our need or encourages us to depend on God and one another in the body of Christ?
6. What might it mean to be *intentionally intrusive* and *grace-centered* in our humble honesty with others?
7. Is there an area of personal growth or personal struggle that God might be leading you to share about with the group? In what way(s) do you need God's help? Please share.
