- 4. What's the difference between *mercy* and *grace*? How has God shown you, personally, mercy and grace in your life?
- 5. How does God's mercy and grace to you help you offer mercy and grace to others?
- 6. Read <u>Matthew 18:15-20</u>. What does this text tell us about dealing with sin among two believers?
- 7. What commitment(s) is God asking you to trust Him to help you make so that He would produce a heart of forgiveness in you?
