 - b. What is helpful about this definition?
4. Read [2 Corinthians 5:14-21](#).
 - a. What does this passage tell us about our reconciliation with God?
 - b. How might seeking reconciliation with others be a way of pointing others to reconciliation with God?
5. How does understanding our identity in Christ help us navigate conflicts in our relationships?
6. What does it mean to have humble honesty when facing relational conflicts?
7. How can you better embrace grace and forgiveness in your interactions with those who hurt you?
