- 3. Who were the people questioning John, and why were they asking him about his identity (verses 19-22)?
- 4. How does John describe Jesus in verse 29? What do you think is the significance of the title "the Lamb of God"?
- 5. How does John conclude his testimony in verse 34? Why is this declaration important?
- 6. Share about a time when you had an opportunity to talk about Jesus with someone. How did it go? What did you learn from the experience?
- 7. What are some challenges you face when trying to point someone towards Jesus? How can we overcome those challenges?
