- 5. Read Romans 8:1-15. In what way(s) does this passage offer words of hope to you in your everyday living?
- 6. Considering the Scripture texts we've discussed, what specifically is God asking you to do, trust, think, or believe this week?
- 7. New City Catechism Question 3: How many persons are there in God? (There are three persons in one God: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.)
