- Jesus had a seemingly "random" conversation with the Samaritan woman (it wasn't really random!). Have you ever had a "chance" encounter with someone that turned into a meaningful conversation?
- Read John 4:1-15. Why do you think Jesus "had to" go through Samaria? What does this tell us about his mission?
- Jesus engaged immediately with the Samaritan woman with the gospel, crossing over cultural barriers to do so. What barriers exist today that might keep us from reaching out to certain people?
- Jesus offers living water that truly satisfies. What are some things people chase after today that leave them spiritually thirsty?
- Read Isaiah 55:1-13. Why do people "spend their money for that which is not bread" and "labor for that which does not satisfy"? What are some modern examples of this?
- Isaiah 55:6-7 urges people to seek the Lord while he may be found. How does this shape our sense of urgency in pursuing God and sharing the gospel with others?
- Think about the ways Jesus satisfies you personally. Can you share a moment when you clearly felt that satisfaction in him?
